Requirements:

1. In Mesa County and the City of Grand Junction it shall be unlawful for any dog that has been found to be a Dangerous Dog by any Court to be confined in a manner that does not include the following requirements. When outside the owner's primary residence, the dog must be:
 - confined to an escape proof kennel approved by Mesa County Animal Services; or
 - on a leash and under the direct control of a responsible adult; and
 - confined in such a manner that complies with any additional safety or confinement restrictions ordered by the Court that found the dog Dangerous unless amended by a Court in our jurisdiction.
2. In Mesa County and the City of Grand Junction the owner of any dog that has been found to be a Dangerous Dog by any Court and is residing in Mesa County or the City of Grand Junction must obtain an annual special permit and identification tag for such animal. The permit shall expire on December 31 of the year for which the permit is issued. An application for the special permit and identification tag shall be made to Mesa County Animal Services thirty days prior to the expiration date of the existing permit along with the Dangerous Dog Special Permit fee of \$100. The Dangerous Dog Special Permit tag shall be worn by the dog at all times.
3. The owner shall allow the Mesa County Animal Services Officer access to the property where the dangerous dog is being harbored for inspections and ensure compliance for the duration of the life of the animal. Prior to approving the annual permit, an inspection of the escape proof kennel where the dangerous dog is harbored will be completed by Mesa County Animal Services. If

any problems are noted with the kennel, they must be corrected before the annual permit is approved.

4. The owner shall allow the Mesa County Animal Services Officer to photograph the dog and the confinement area and to verify the microchip. Please provide a minimum of three dates and times (approximately 30 minutes) that the officer can meet with you to complete these items. An officer will contact you to set an appointment.

5. The owner shall notify Mesa County Animal Services in writing a minimum of seven (7) days prior to change in the address of the owner or the location of the dog.
6. If the dog was found to be Dangerous by a Court outside of Mesa County, the dog owner will provide Mesa County Animal Services with contact information and case information of the sentencing jurisdiction.

Additional Requirements Specific to Court Order

The Court ordered the following requirements in addition to the above:

- ☐ The dog shall be muzzled whenever it is outside of the approved building/enclosure.
- ☐ The dog owner shall post a conspicuous warning sign on the building or enclosure notifying others that a dangerous dog is housed in the building or enclosure.
- ☐ Prior to a change, transfer, or termination of ownership of a dangerous dog, the owner must disclose in writing to the prospective owner that the dangerous dog has been the subject of a conviction of this section.
- ☐ The dog owner shall permanently identify the dangerous dog through the implantation of a microchip by a licensed veterinarian or shelter.

I have read and understand the above requirements pertaining to the registration permit of a Dangerous Dog and agree to comply with all requirements set forth by applicable ordinances and resolutions established by the City of Grand Junction and Mesa County. I agree to allow the Mesa County Animal Services Officer or his/her designee access to the property where my dog is owned, kept, or harbored for the purpose of inspection and verifying compliance with the regulations and ordinances pertaining to property animal care. I also understand that if my previously determined dangerous dog is found to be confined in a manner not meeting the confinement guidelines or is found to be running at large, the dog will be impounded by Mesa County Animal Services until a Judge determines the outcome of any pending charges and disposition of the Dangerous Dog.
