Apatosaurus was found in 1901 by Elmer Riggs at Dinosaur Hill.

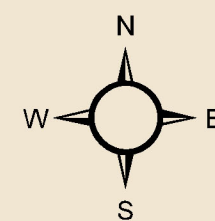
